Dear Parents:

I trust that you are enjoying the summer and spending some time relaxing with family and friends.

This mailing includes a detailed calculation of your net tuition for the 2023-2024 school year, payment options, and an application for school society membership. Please double-check the **Tuition Contract** to make sure it is accurate; for example, if it states you are receiving a "Sibling at Partner School" discount when you no longer have another child attending a recognized Christian Elementary School, please let me know and I will make the correction.

The Tuition as indicated has been reduced by including an income component (this year \$800) from our Involved Parent Network (IPN). Service opportunities, involvement information, expectations, and other details regarding the IPN program will come your way later in August or September from the Advancement/Development Office.

To make the Involved Parent Network a success, your participation is important. If you were not able to be involved using your time or talents this past year, we ask you to make a concerted effort to be involved this year as opportunities arise. If you are not able to put in time, we ask you to contribute to the IPN program by making a voluntary suggested minimum donation of \$800 toward the Tuition Assistance Fund to cover the tuition reduction. You will receive a receipt for tax purposes for donations given to the Tuition Assistance Fund.

**Tuition fees are to be paid in advance, either in full, or by monthly instalments over 10 or 12 months. Please submit your payment agreement and schedule as soon as possible and no later than Friday August 4.**

Please take advantage of our electronic direct deposit Preauthorized Debit (PAD) method. PAD is much more efficient and saves us a great deal of administrative time. This form of payment is as safe as post-dated cheques. Rather than physically writing cheques, you are giving Woodland permission to debit your bank account in the amount and on the date indicated via a signed PAD schedule. Please complete the form found with this mailing and attach a cheque (copy or photo) marked "void" (not necessary if we have your current bank information on file). These PADs will be electronically forwarded to the bank twice monthly as indicated on the schedule.

Thank you in advance for your support and cooperation. Please continue to pray for the school, its students, and staff. It is our prayer that your child will have a great 2023-2024 school year here at Woodland!

Dear Parents:

Another school year is before us, and it is a privilege for us at Woodland Christian High School to have your child here as part of this Christian community of learning. We are looking forward to a very good year of providing excellent Christian education for the young people that attend our school. We are mindful of God's blessings in years past and we look forward with the hope and expectation that God's blessings will continue to sustain us.

We are also thankful for the support that we have received from the parents in our community. The purpose of this letter is to invite you to become members or to renew your membership in the Cambridge and District Association for Christian Education, which operates Woodland.

I would like to briefly summarize the membership structure of the Cambridge District Association for Christian Education.

1. Membership in the Cambridge District Association for Christian Education, (also called Woodland membership) the Association which owns and operates Woodland Christian High School, is separate from the admission of students to the school. In other words, parents who send their children to Woodland are not automatically members of Woodland.
2. Membership in Woodland is for individuals only. For example, a husband and wife must each apply for membership and must each pay membership fees.

The membership fee for parents who have children attending Woodland is \$25 per member where the member is a parent of a student enrolled at the school. In cases where both parents wish to be members, the fee would be \$50.

Why should you become members?

1. Membership in the Association entitles you to serve on the Board of Directors of Woodland Christian High School.
2. Membership entitles you to vote at meetings where the affairs of the Association and the school are discussed, where policies are decided and where budgets are approved.
3. Membership is your expression of support for Christian secondary education and of your willingness to contribute your time and talents to the operation of this school. It is your commitment to providing a Christ centred education to the young people in your community and to being involved in protecting and advancing the vision of Christian education for the present and the future. Membership makes you a partner in the training of our children in the way of the Lord.

Please consider joining us by completing the attached form. You may include a separate cheque for your membership fees or include the fee on the form with the tuition letter included in this mailing.

We appreciate your support. Please uphold the school, the students, the teachers and the support staff in your prayers this year as you have done so faithfully in the past.

*I believe in God, the Father almighty,

*I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit  
and born of the virgin Mary.*

*He suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried;  
he descended to hell.*

*The third day he rose again from the dead.*

*He ascended to heaven  
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty.*

*From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.*

*I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic\* church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,

This creed is called the Apostles' Creed not because it was produced by the apostles themselves but because it contains a brief summary of their teachings. It sets forth their doctrine "in sublime simplicity, in unsurpassable brevity, in beautiful order, and with liturgical solemnity." In its present form it is dated no later than the fourth century. More than any other Christian creed, it may justly be called an ecumenical symbol of faith.
